

## Presentation of internships in Brazilian museums

ICOM Brazil, the Organising Committee of ICOM Rio 2013 and their partners are pleased to announce internships in Brazilian museums, within the travel grant programme for the 23<sup>rd</sup> ICOM General Conference. Partners in this programme are the Secretaries of Culture of different Brazilian states and universities.

Internships will be offered in Brazilian museums for those grantees interested in spending up to two weeks visiting a particular museum in Brazil and who will be attending the General Conference.

Depending on the interest of grantees, various museums will receive interns for a period of observation of up to two weeks in the area of museum work chosen by the intern. The museum will designate a member of its staff to accompany the intern during the entire period, ensuring that the grantee completes their activities in the museum in an optimal fashion. If the chosen museum is located in a city other than Rio de Janeiro, travel to and from Rio to attend the General Conference will be provided, as well as accommodation and meals in the same city. Interns must submit a report by the end of the internship period, to be made available particularly in the grantee's country of origin, in order to share their experience with as many colleagues as possible.

If you are interested in this internship programme, please respond to the attached questionnaire and enclose it with your application. Based on the answers to the questionnaire, the Organising Committee of ICOM Rio 2013 will search for Brazilian museums that best suit each grantee's areas of interest, and will get in contact with the grantees concerning the logistical details.
